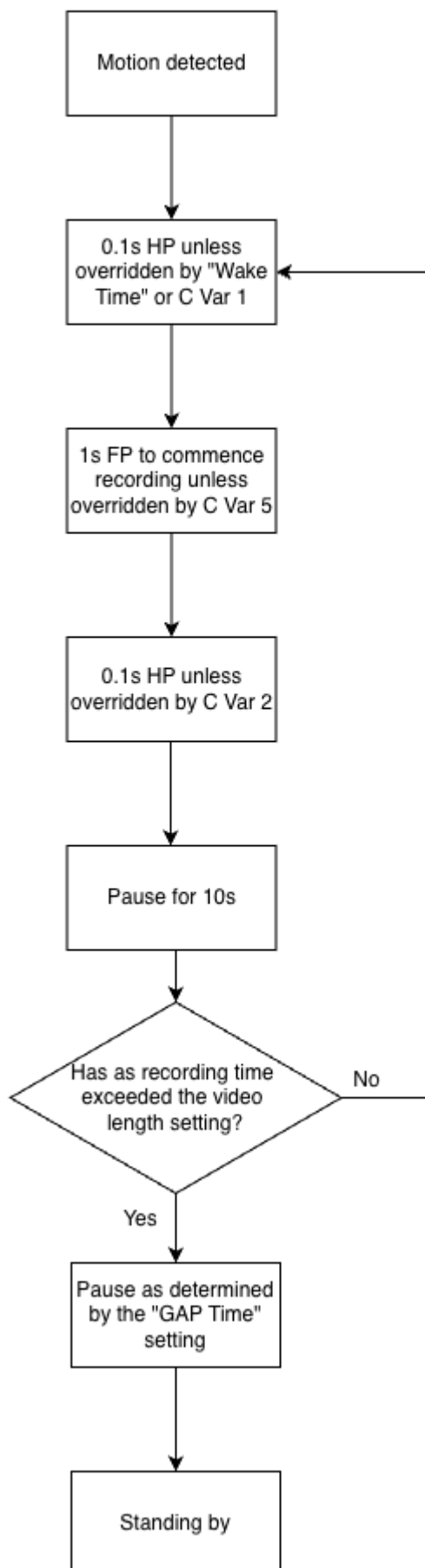


Video Sequence Timings

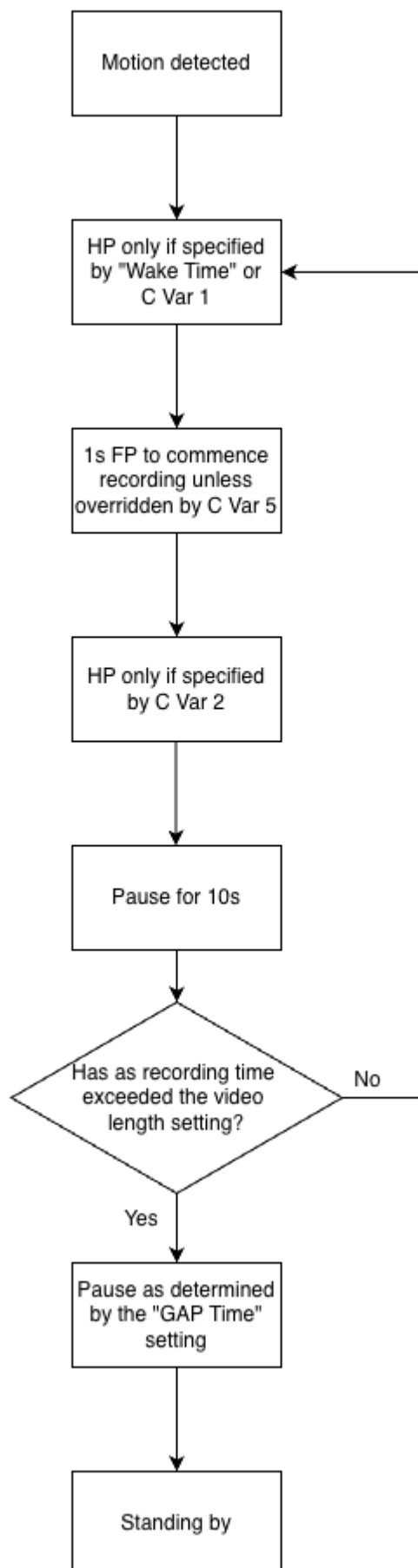
These flowcharts outline the sequence of operations when the sensor is set to **Video Mode**, for both Wireless and Wired outputs, including all optional timing adjustments via menu settings and **Custom Variables (C Vars)**.

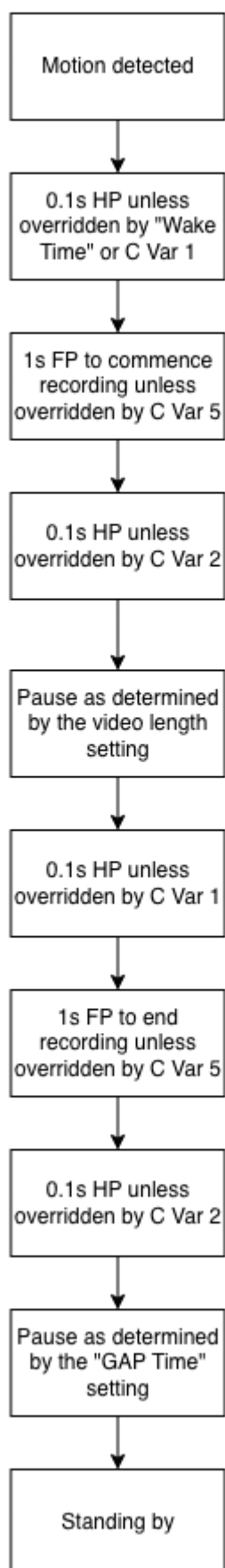


Wired Mode 1

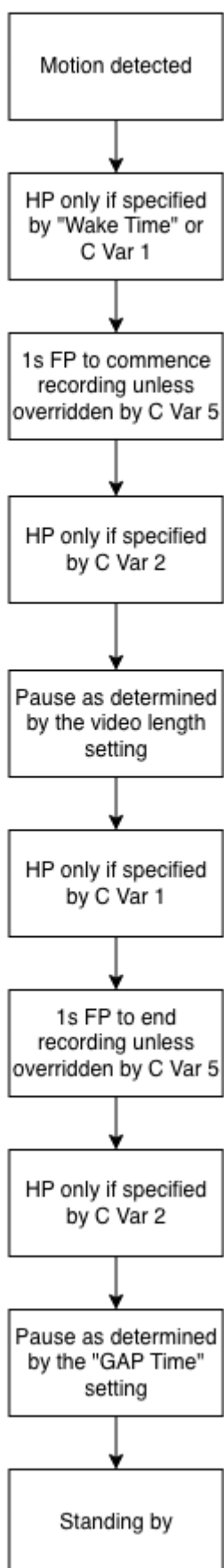

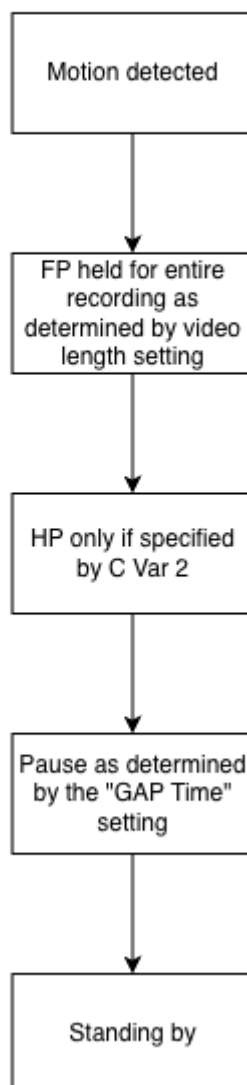

Signal Key

Abbreviation	Meaning	Description
HP	Half-Press	A half-press signal sent to the camera to wake it or initiate autofocus.
FP	Full-Press	A full-press signal that triggers the camera's shutter release or starts/stops video recording.

Notes – Video Mode

- **EXT Mode:** Extends recording if motion continues; use C Var 6 to impose a maximum video length limit.
 - **Time Windows:** Sequence only operates within defined On Time periods; outside these times, motion is ignored.
